Legislative Update

It's official: the 2009 legislative year will go down in the record books. As we get ready to close the books on the 2009 legislative year (September 30 is the traditional end of our legislative year), we have 130 enactments and 272 introductions. This ties us for our best year ever (in 1999 we also had 130 enactments). Massachusetts and New Mexico lead the way with 10 and 9 enactments respectively. Nevada and North Dakota finished the year with 7 enactments each, Oklahoma had 6 enactments, and Maine and Washington each finished the year with 5 enactments. As a matter of fact, nearly every state posted at least one enactment – which made the 2009 record truly a nationwide effort.

New Jersey Commissioner Barry Evenchick was recently appointed by Governor Jon S. Corzine to the Waterfront and Airport Commission of New York and New Jersey.
